

SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

RATIONALE:

A school uniform helps encourage a pride in school and the development of a team and school spirit. The uniform identifies students as belonging to Target Road School.

GUIDELINES:

1. All children are expected to wear the prescribed uniform:
 - Tops
 - School polo shirt
 - School sweat shirt
 - Optional:
 - Polo fleece vest
 - Bottom/Unisex
 - Cargo shorts (black or sand)
 - Cargo pants (black)
 - $\frac{3}{4}$ Cargo pants (sand)
 - Girls:
 - Scooter (black)
 - Skirt (sand)
 - Bootleg Pant (black)
 - Flare leg Pant (black)

(Note. Parents are able to provide their children with look-alike items i.e. for bottom wear similar design and with no labels, other colours or stripes)

- Hat - All children must wear a school labeled sand bucket hat in Terms 1 and 4. A black school labeled cap may be worn in terms 2 and 3.
2. On wet and cold days, children may wear jackets or appropriate rainwear to and from school. All such extra clothing is to be removed on arrival at school.
 3. Children travelling on school trips must be wearing correct school uniform.
 4. Jewellery is not part of our school uniform. However, children who have pierced ears may wear one stud in each ear at school.
 5. The school bucket hat must be worn outside in school time during Terms One and Four. Non-compliance will mean children will be withdrawn from the playground and appropriately supervised.
 6. Shoes and socks when worn should not clash with the uniform. Therefore the Board has resolved that all footwear must be black or sand and socks or tights, if worn, black or white.
 7. Parents who are unable to have their children comply with the school policy will be required to make an appointment to discuss the matter with the Principal. Unresolved issues will be considered by a meeting of the Board of Trustees.

NB. It is expected that all children's uniform items will be clearly named to establish ownership and to help with the return of misplaced items.
